CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Bobbie Jones called the meeting of the Upper Coastal Plain Council of Governments Board of Directors to order at 6:45 p.m. He welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for taking the time to attend. He introduced new Board members Paolo Ceyrolles (Wilson County), Walter Wells (Town of Bailey), Currie Joyner (Wilson County) and Sammy Hopkins (Town of Whitakers) and special guests in attendance. Roll was called and attendance was duly noted.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

Chairman Jones called for a Motion to approve the Consent Agenda items which included the approval of the meeting Minutes from March 19, 2024, approval of February 2024 and March 2024 financial reports, approval of the AAA Area Plan, approval of the NCORR Regional Housing Needs Assessment, approval of the Workforce Development Consortium Agreement and approval of the UCPCOG Personnel Policy Manual update. A Motion was made by Ms. Barbara Simmons and seconded by Ms. Tawanda Moore. All voted in favor. The Motion carried and the consent agenda was approved.

ACTION ITEMS

FY24 – 25 Proposed Budget and Public hearing Date – Kelly Lancaster – Finance Director

Ms. Lancaster presented the Fiscal year 2024 – 2025 proposed budget for review. She explained that overall funding reflected in this proposed budget is reduced from the FY23 budget due to expiration of ARPA funding and based on estimates of known revenues at this time. After a few questions, Chairman Jones called for a Motion to approve the proposed budget and set the date for the public hearing. A Motion was made by Mr. Gregory Browning and seconded by Mr. Mark Frohman. All voted in favor and the proposed budget was approved and the public hearing date was set for June 18, 2024.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT – Gregory Browning, Nominating Committee Chair

Mr. Browning reported that generally the Vice-Chair moves up to assume the position of Board Chair and the current Secretary/Treasurer moves up to assume the position of Vice-Chair. He was happy to announce that both Miranda Boykin and Dia Denton had graciously agreed to serve. After much deliberation, the nominating committee has agreed to appoint Mr. James Alson as the incoming Secretary/Treasurer, pending Board approval. There being no discussion, Chairman Jones called for a Motion to approve the appointment. A Motion was made by Mr. Fred Belfield and seconded by Ms. Sherry Lucas. The motion carried unanimously.

NCARCOG UPDATE

Mr. Gregory Browning shared an update from the North Carolina Association of Regional Councils of Government. He gave a re-cap of the Forum meeting that was held in Charlotte in April, as well as the very productive Legislative Day that was held in Raleigh in June.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Hiett referred the Board to his Executive Director's Report beginning on Page 46 of the agenda packet. He highlighted a few items in his report. He reported that support is increasing for the prosperity zones. He referred the Board to House Bill 1007 located on page 54 of the agenda packet and stated that this bill does have bi-partisan support. Lastly, he shared information about an upcoming SOG workshop that may be of interest to Board members.

IMPACT REPORTS

Aging – Ms. Mary Marlin, Aging Director

Ms. Marlin called the Board's attention to the Aging Impact report located on page 66 of the agenda packet. She reminded everyone about the upcoming Regional Aging Conference which will be held on June 13, 2024, at Edgecombe Community College in Tarboro. She also stated

that we are currently recruiting volunteers. If you or someone you know is interested, please contact her. Lastly, she reported that with ARPA funding ending, the Consumer Supported Agriculture boxes will end. Final deliveries will be in June.

Planning and Development Services – Ben Farmer, PDS Director

Mr. Farmer called the Board's attention to the Planning and Development Services Impact Report beginning on Page 67 of the agenda packet. He highlighted the department's new grant total which is \$29 million. He reported that the March Disaster Recovery training held at Nash Community College in May was very well attended and very productive. He also announced that they will be hiring another Climate Action Corps member who will begin in September. There is more information on the flyer on page 73 of the agenda packet.

Workforce Development – Michael Williams, Workforce Development Director

Mr. Williams called the Board's attention to the Workforce Development Impact Report on Pages 74 - 76 of the agenda packet. He reviewed the unemployment rates and trends and LMI data for March, 2024.
