CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chairperson Denton called the meeting of the Upper Coastal Plain Council of Governments Board of Directors to order at 6:49 p.m. She welcomed all in attendance, introduced special guests and thanked them for taking the time to attend. Roll was called and attendance was duly noted.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

Vice Chairperson Denton called for a Motion to approve the Consent Agenda items which included approval of the June 18, 2024 meeting minutes, May and June, 2024 financial reports, PDS budget amendment, travel/meal policy revision, EPA community change grant, clean fuels and advanced technology grant, NCORR housing study grant, Pew charitable trust fiscal land use and 3d modeling project and artificial intelligence (AI) governance policy. A Motion was made by Mr. Eddie Braxton and seconded by Mr. Ralph Webb. All voted in favor. The Motion carried and the consent agenda was approved.

SPEAKER PRESENTATIONS

Bryashia Buggs, Regional Director from the office of U.S. Representative Don Davis, Trey Lewis, Northeast Regional Representative from the office of U.S. Senator Thom Tillis, and John Tayloe, Northeast Regional Director from the office of U.S. Senator Ted Budd all gave an update of matters of concern that are taking place in our Region. Each speaker urged anyone that needed assistance to feel free to reach out to their respective offices.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Vice Chairperson Denton gave an update from the Bylaws committee. She shared that after several meetings and much deliberation, we will be presenting the proposed new Bylaws to the Board at the October meeting. She outlined some of the major changes and opened the floor for questions.

Next, she reported that in an effort to conserve funding, we have decided not to have our annual banquet in November. The regularly scheduled October meeting will be used for staff recognition and awards.

NCARCOG UPDATE

Mr. Gregory Browning shared a brief update from the North Carolina Association of Regional Councils of Government. Although there hasn't been a forum meeting since our last Board meeting, Mr. Browning shared the progress of several items that we have been advocating for in the State Legislature. He reported that he is very proud of the progress that is being made.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT – Robert Hiett, Executive Director

Mr. Hiett called the Board's attention to his report beginning on Page 29 of the agenda packet. He briefly highlighted a few items in his report including his work with Rocky Mount leaders to design a commuter bus program that would connect workers to employment centers. He also discussed declining Aging funds and potential approaches to securing more funding.

Next, he discussed his artificial intelligence (AI) training to date and how this would benefit all member governments in the future. He discussed the "Train the Trainer" model to develop inhouse expertise and developing strategic partnerships to deliver services and opportunities for member governments.

PROGRAM IMPACT REPORTS AND UPDATES

Aging – Ms. Mary Marlin, Aging Director

Ms. Marlin referred the Board to her impact report on page 40 of the agenda packet. She reviewed the service numbers for the previous fiscal year. She also reported that the Wright's Center has secured a grant of \$250,000 and she looks forward to seeing the great impact this funding will have in our region. She closed by announcing that the next RAAC meeting will be held via zoom on September 24, 2024 at 10:00 a.m.

Planning and Development Services – Mr. Ben Farmer, PDS Director

Mr. Farmer referred the Board to his impact report beginning on Page 41 of the agenda packet. He introduced our newest employee, Ms. Liz Raskopf, who will be the new Community Development Manager. He spoke about the upcoming CEDS strategy Development Group (SDG) workshop to be held on August 27 from 11 – 2 at Nash Community College and urged all Board members to attend. He closed by reviewing regional and local project highlights.

Workforce Development Services – Mr. Michael Williams, Workforce Development Director

Mr. Williams referred the Board to his impact report located on page 47 of the agenda packet. He reviewed the service numbers for May through July, 2024 and the Regional Labor Market Overview. He spoke of several new employment opportunities, as well as a few employer layoffs in the region. He was excited to announce that many of the workers being laid off had secured new employment.

There being no further business, Vice Chairperson Denton announced that our next meeting will be held on October 15, 2024, in the Brown Auditorium on the campus of Nash Community College at 6:45 p.m. She then called for a Motion to adjourn.
